With help from our friends at Cyr Lumber & Home Center and Maine Drilling & Blasting we were able to present the Carpentry & Construction program with tools and supplies from their wish list!

What is CTE?!!!!

Career Technical Education (CTE) provides learners with the knowledge and skills they need to be prepared for college and careers. CTE gives purpose to learning by emphasizing real-world skills and practical knowledge within a selected career focus.

Students in CTE programs take specialized courses, in addition to required courses, and often have the opportunity to participate in internships, engage with mentors and practice what they are learning through handson projects. Students can participate in CTE at the middle or high school level and at postsecondary institutions in all communities, in all states, across the U.S.

CTE Fun Facts-

- CTE learners and their parents are three times more likely to report that they are very satisfied with their ability to learn real world skills as compared to non-CTE learners and their parents
- Over 75% of CTE learners enroll in postsecondary education after high school.
- CTE learners have a 10% higher high school graduation rate than non-CTE students.
- 89% of parents think students should receive more education about career choices while in high school.
- Six of the ten hardest-to-fill positions are in technical fields or require a CTE background.
- About half of all CTE learners are enrolled in programs in leading fields such as health care, STEM and information technology.
- More than twice as many CTE parents report being satisfied with internship opportunities.
