





- 3 An abbreviation for "cubic feet per minute"
- 11 Usually lightweight louvered decorative frames in form of doors located on the sides of a window.
- 12 Supporting portion of a structure below the first floor construction.
- 13 Short elevation of an exterior wall above the deck of a roof.
- 14 Fitting that lets you change directions in runs of pipe.
- 15 Extremely thin sheets of wood.
- 16 Pesticide substance that will prevent the action of wooddestroying fungi, insect borers and similar destructive agents.
- 17 Wall placed at the edge of a roof to prevent people from falling off.
- 18 Wood eating insects.

- 1 Often used in reference to rough frame opening members.
- 2 Money set aside in construction contract for items not selected and specified in construction contract.
- 4 Slot cut into board to receive the tenon (or tongue) of another board to form a joint.



- 5 Pane of glass.
- 6 All of the metal fittings that go into a home.
- 7 1x4 board let into the studs horizontally to support ceiling or second-floor joists.
- 8 Upright framing member in panel door.
- 9 Water pipe installed in a water meter pit.
- 10 Rail, posts and vertical balusters along the edge of stairway or elevated walkway.
